

PASTOR WELCOMED BY FLOCK AFTER SERVING TERM IN JAIL

Convicted Under Mann Act, the
Rev. Finis Dake of Zion, Ill.,
Urges Past Be Forgotten.

ZION, Ill., July 19.—The Rev. Finis Jennings Dake, back from five months' confinement in the Milwaukee (Wis.) House of Correction, was welcomed enthusiastically by his Christian Assembly Church congregation yesterday. In his address he warned his parishioners against "human weaknesses" and urged them to "forget the past."

Dake was convicted in Federal Court on charges of violating the Mann Act. He was accused of taking a 16-year-old Kenosha (Wis.) girl on trips to Bloomington and East St. Louis, Ill. He is 35 years old, married and has an 8-year-old daughter.
