

Pastor Gets Six Months In Mann Act Violation

**Rev. Finis J. Dake Indicted Year
Ago On Charge Of Taking Girl
From Wisconsin To Illinois**

Milwaukee, Feb. 9 (AP)—The Rev. Finis Jennings Dake, 34, pastor of the Christian Assembly Church at Zion, Ill., was sentenced in Federal Court today to six months' imprisonment on a plea of guilty to a charge of violating the Mann Act.

More than one hundred of his parishioners were in the courtroom as the pastor was brought before Federal Judge F. A. Geiger. Dake was indicted a year ago on a charge of taking a 16-year-old girl from Kenosha, Wis., to East St. Louis, Ill., in 1935. He had been under \$2,000 bond.

At one time a follower of Wilbur Glenn Voliva, Zion overseer, Dake later broke away from Voliva's Christian Apostolic Church to found his rival Christian Assembly Church.
