

Congregation Prays For Rev. Finis Dake

Zion, Ill.—(AP)—The Rev. Finis Jennings Dake, who posted a \$2,000 bond for release from the county jail where he was held on charges of violating the Mann act, announced Sunday that his congregation and the Pentacostal council was supporting him in his fight for vindication.

Appearing before his congregation for the first time since he was seized by federal agents, Dake denied that he took a girl from Kenosha, Wis., to East St. Louis, Ill.

Three hundred members of the congregation prayed as an affirmation of faith in their pastor.
